## Educator Resource Center

The Everson Educator Resource Center (ERC) serves as a research site and lending library to help area educators, including teachers and home educators of all subject areas, integrate art into their classrooms. The ERC provides a distinctive collection of art and culture related materials, technology, and services to enliven students learning experiences through art, all at no cost.

Resources available for loan include art reference texts, interdisciplinary curricula, Visual Thinking Strategies materials, multicultural art objects, art reproductions, children's books, games, educational videos and more!

## Location

The ERC is located on the lower level of the Museum in the Art Zone Classroom. The research kiosk includes laptops with wireless internet access, a scanner and color printer.

## Hours

## ERC Circulation Policies

- Users must register to borrow items
- All materials are for private study and/or educational purposes only
- There are no fees to borrow resources
- Resources may be borrowed for three weeks
- Items may be renewed one time for an additional three weeks unless a hold has been placed
- A maximum of five resources may be checked out at any given time
- Contact the Education Department to request a hold
- Resources must be picked up from and returned to the ERC
- A \$1 fine will be incurred for each day past due
- The borrower will be financially responsible for any lost or damaged materials
