## About Student Art Open:

The Everson Museum of Art Student Art Open (SAO) is a biannual high school program that exists to provide a forum for young artists to create art inspired by issues of importance to them, both personal and social. To this end each SAO offers themes related to specific Everson exhibitions as a catalyst for artistic creation. The program consists of a workshop for educators, curriculum packets, class tours of the exhibition, and culminates in a juried student exhibition.

## Good Design:

### Stories from Herman Miller

August 15, 2010 – October 17, 2010

This exhibition explores the collaborative design process employed at Herman Miller, the world-renowned furniture company that has used design to solve problems for the home and workplace for almost ninety years. *Good Design* showcases archival holdings of concept models, drawings, supplementary photographs and completed masterworks of design in furniture and decorative art produced by Herman Miller, Inc. Works by Gilbert Rohde, Ray and Charles Eames, George Nelson, Alexander Girard, Robert Probst, Bill Stumpf, Don Chadwick, Ayse Birdsel, and other well known designers are featured.

## The Edge of Art: New York State Artist Series Designed to Scale

August 14, 2010 – October 24, 2010

Designed to Scale, showcases significant designers from the Central New York region whose work is recognized in the national and international design arenas.

This year's *Designing the Future* takes inspiration from *Good Design: Stories from Herman Miller*, and invites students to explore ways to apply design in new and exciting ways. Design is an expression, a means to participate in the world, and a way to make change. *Designing the Future* encourages students to create original, dynamic and innovative designs – furniture, surface pattern, graphic, accessories, toys and product. Think beyond the conventional and what is possible today to what could be possible in the future.
