Withdrawal/ Refund Policy

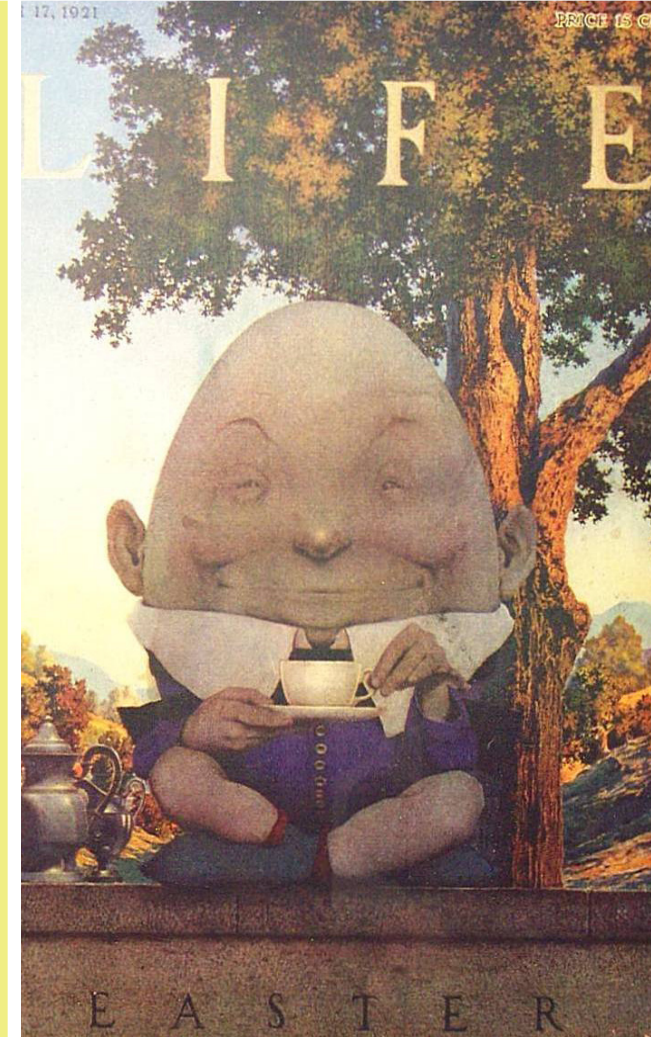
In the event you must withdraw from any classes we require 2 weeks advanced notice or a 20% cancellation fee will be incurred. No refunds after the first class.
